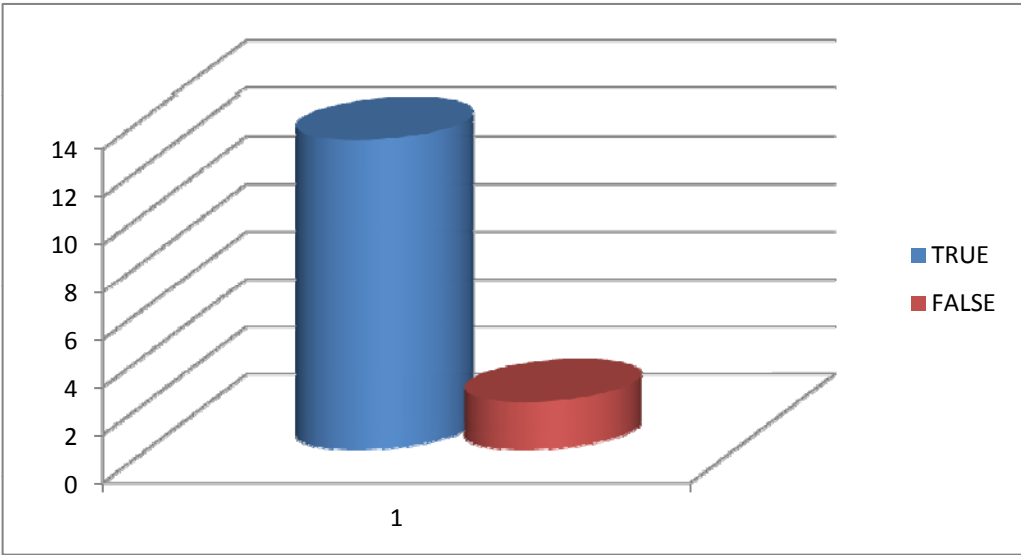

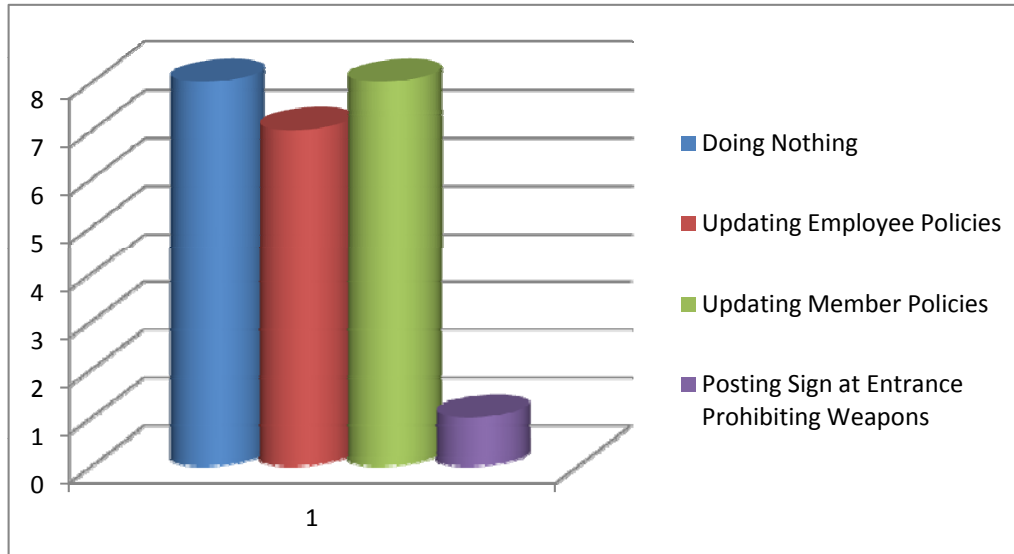

While XYZ Club recognizes an individual's right to carry a weapon as accorded in Wisconsin's  
Act 35, we have reserved the right to deny the presence of any weapon,  
concealed or otherwise, anywhere on Club Property. Thank You, XYZ Club Management and  
Board of Directors  
Our Board is currently drafting text for both the employee handbook and member rules, but  
is undecided about posting signs at club entrances.

**Additional Comments:**

We are waiting for a legal opinion on whether to post signs or not.  
As a function of our annual review of the Employee handbook as well as the Club's House  
Rules, we will be including similar language requiring that no weapon will be allowed on  
Club Property. The Only signage we will be using will be a the service entrance where all  
employees must access the Clubhouse. This is also the door at which all deliveries are made.  
Discussion will be at our October Board of Directors meeting.
