

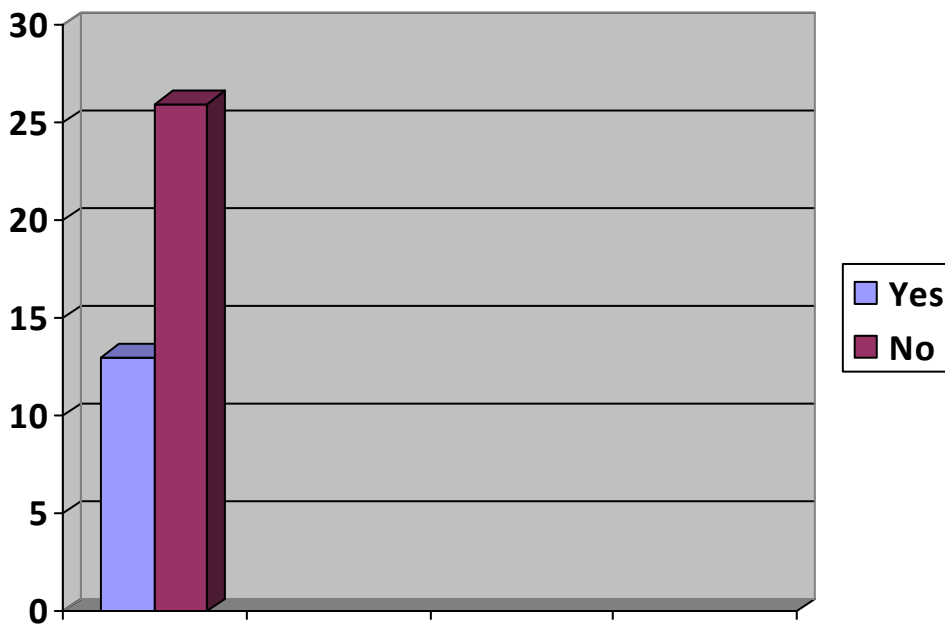
Corporate Membership Survey

The Badger Chapter membership was asked if their clubs had corporate memberships available. Of the 107 surveyed, 39 responded. The results are as follows:

Does your club have Corporate Memberships?

13 - Yes (33.33%)

26 - No (66.66%)



Comments:

1. This is for dining only—no social events or sport activities—bill must be paid with corporate check and each name on the corporate account must be accepted into the club under regular membership approval rules.
2. It is called business associate. It is transferable but only with club approval of the new member. Primary member pays the same fees as full members. All subsequent secondary members pay half initiation fees.
3. I would like to see what the results are.
4. We only have on of these and only ever have had one. We will be unlikely to promote them much as the category id marginal vis a vis the Tax Code.
5. We offer a Corporate Golf and a Corporate Social Membership. Both are designed to be memberships for individuals at a corporation with a discount given for the fourth person +.
