



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

INFORMATION & ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The Wisconsin Club Managers Foundation (WCMF) is the educational funding and philanthropic arm of the Wisconsin Badger Chapter of Club Management Association of America (CMAA).

The purpose of the Student Scholarship Fund is to foster study of the private club industry in schools and universities and to promote a closer affiliation between students and the professionals working in the industry.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The WCMF awards two scholarships (\$1,500 and \$1,000) each year. Scholarship winners are selected by the Student Scholarship Allocation Committee. The scholarship award is made directly to the registrar at the college or university the recipient attends.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

Any individual who is actively seeking a managerial career in the private club industry and is currently enrolled in an accredited, two or four-year college or university undergraduate hospitality program, may apply for the scholarship.

CRITERIA

Candidates must provide strong evidence that they are pursuing managerial careers in the private club industry. Candidates must have completed their first year of a two-year program, or the second year of a four-year program and be enrolled for the upcoming academic year. In addition, the candidate must have achieved a grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.

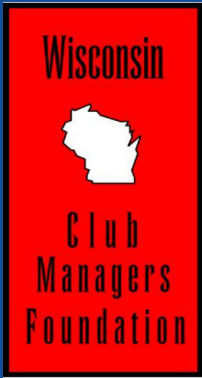

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

PLEASE READ AND CAREFULLY ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Complete and submit a typed, official application by **September 27, 2019**.
 - Write an essay (between 500-1,000 words) addressing the following components;
 - What drew you to the private club industry?
 - What do you see as a challenge to the private club industry and how would you address it?
 - Describe your perfect job.
 - Tell us about a difficult situation you experienced and how you resolved it.
 - Why do you feel that you should be a WCMF Student Scholarship recipient?
 - Submit a copy of your college transcript.
 - Provide letters of recommendation from a faculty advisor/professor and a private club industry professional. The recommendation letters must be typed on Club/University letterhead and be hand-signed by the individual writing the recommendation.
 - Provide a copy of your current resume.
 - Sign and date the application.
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- All information must be received by **September 27, 2019**. There are no exceptions. Missing items will result in disqualification of your application. Decisions on awards will be made in early October; applicants will be notified by mail with regard to their award status. Scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the Wisconsin Badger Chapter Annual Meeting on October 21st at North Shore Country Club.

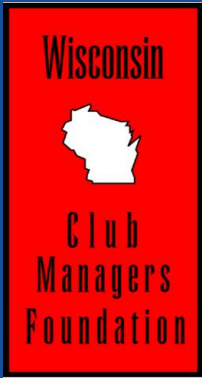
